



Getting Into the Routine

The use of daily routines and naturally occurring events as a context for early intervention services is logically appealing, but a relatively new practice challenging therapists trained in a medical model. "Therapists as Collaborative Team members in Infant/toddler Community Services" (TaCTICS) is an outreach project designed to help service providers move from a one-on-one child directed approach supporting interactions between a care giver and their child within daily routines. This presentation identifies ways that therapists can use existing routines or develop new ones to integrate outcomes for therapy.

Objectives

- 1) To increase strategies for identifying routines and events with families and caregivers that are functional for embedded intervention
- 2) to identify techniques for implementing a consultative model in early intervention therapy
